Our oldest running wine, the 2017 is our 14th vintage making our Rosé from the historic Gibson Ranch in the McDowell Valley. Our block dates back to the late 1800's and is home to the oldest planting of Grenache Gris in the United States.

Varietal: Field blend of Grenache Gris

Age: Planted in 1896

Elevation: 950 ft.

Soil: Talmage gravelly sand loam

Harvested: August 31, 2017

Pressed: August 31 after foot treading

Maceration: A few hours

Fermentation: Wild yeasts & bacteria in neutral

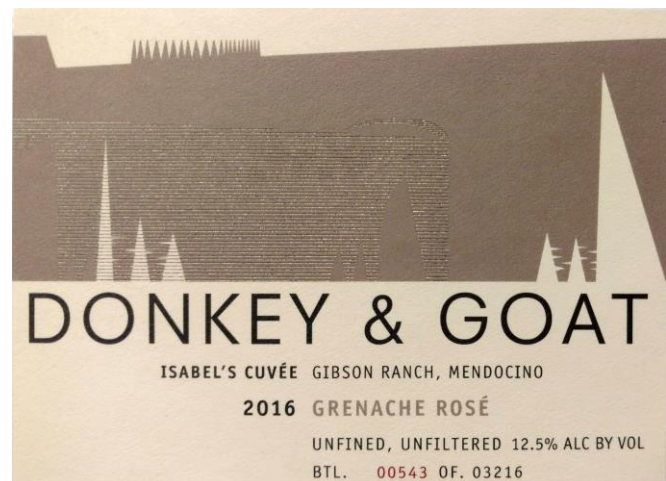
French oak barrels
