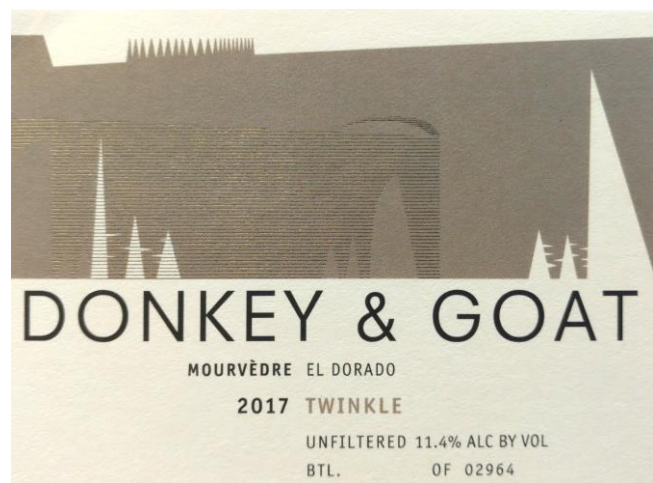
Fermentations: Wild yeasts & bacteria in 5t Taransaud Cuves

### Tasting Note:

*Aromatics and flavor profile are juicy, juicy, juicy for this vintage of Twinkle. A pretty nose of crushed raspberry and strawberry laced with a light dusty fringe. This is a racy and light bodied red wine that leads with flavor profiles matching its aromatics: strawberries, raspberries, a touch of orange zest and pomegranate. Serves as a delightfully refreshing wine, when enjoyed chilled.*
