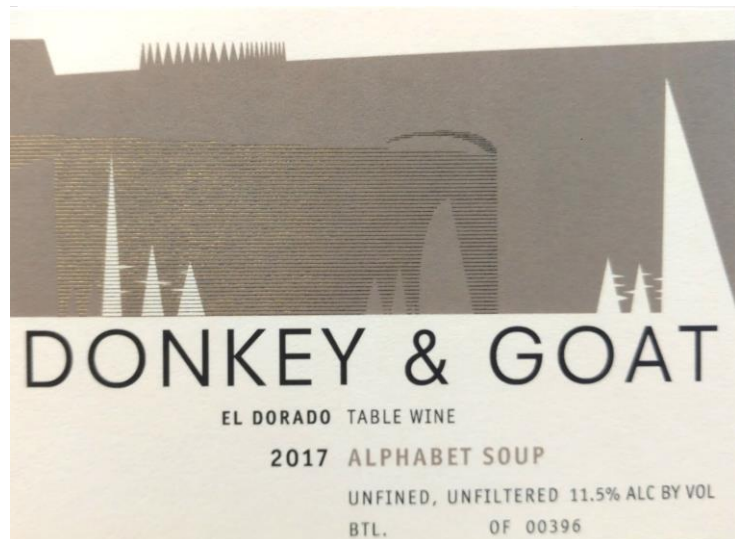

Tasting Note:
