Tasting Note:

It's a feminine and earthy nose shown off by beautiful floral notes of honeysuckle, jasmine, lemongrass, oolong tea, and a whiff of sage. This wine is texturally complex as you start to recognize the components of each varietal. Fruitiness of white peaches, apricots and golden delicious apples. It has a bit of muscle that we think you'll love, influenced by its salinity and with nutty notes of cashew, marzipan.
