Maceration: A few hours

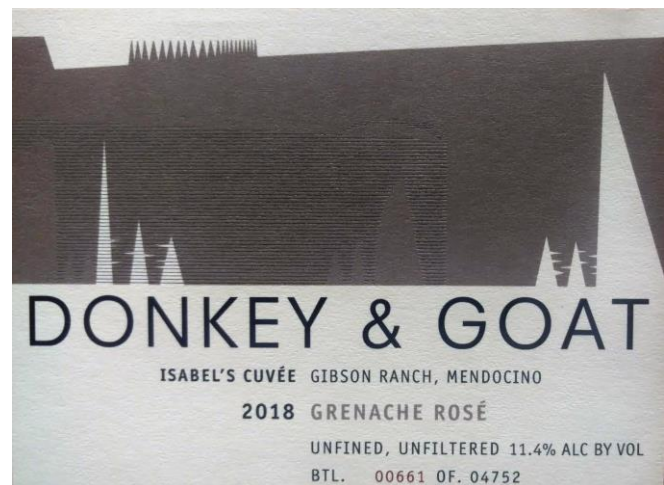
Fermentation: Wild yeasts & bacteria in Taransaud oak vat & neutral oak barrels

The nose is an exploration of strawberries, guava, and rosewater. Fresh and juicy like a homegrown clementine with the crisp, savory, and tangy profile of an underripe peach and a subtle strawberry sweetness.
