These grapes are from a 53 year old vineyard in the Russian River. When we were offered a chance to make Sparkling Pinot Meunier in 2017 the answer was not yes, it was HELL YES. This is one of three unique Pet Nats releasing in 2019. There is no question - this one is a keeper. Like all of our Pet Nats, this is a zero zero wine where we bottle before our spontaneous fermentation completes so it continues in the bottle making those delicate and delicious bubbles.
