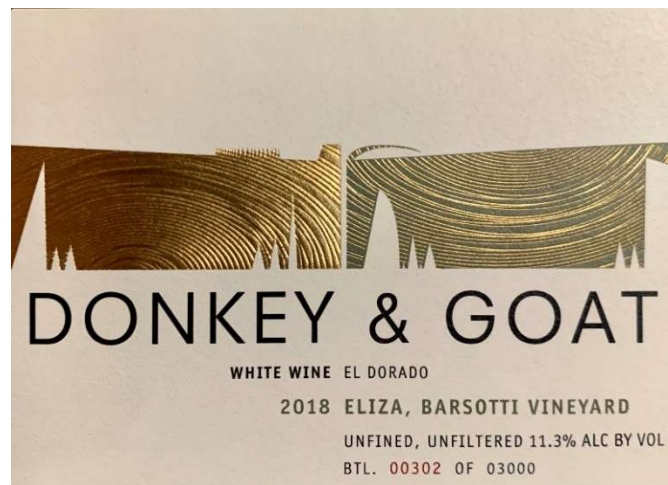




2018 Eliza

Tasting Note:

On the nose, you'll sense the aromas of just-ripened pears, yellow apple and fresh rain. As soon as you take a sip, your palette will liven up with hints of apricot, salted mango and sliced kumquat. Eliza's allure lies in the wine's ability to show off each varietal's character and complexity. The wine's zippy salinity pairs elegantly with foraged mushrooms and squash ravioli. Enjoy on a chilly but bright Spring afternoon.
