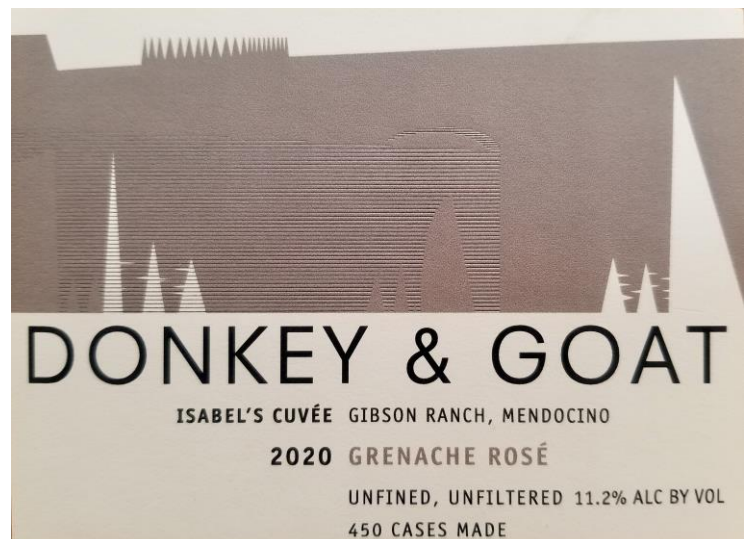
Fermentation: Wild yeasts & bacteria in Taransaud oak vat & neutral oak barrels
