Tasting Note:

Eliza's allure lies in the wine's ability to show off each varietal's character and complexity. On the nose, you'll sense the bright aromas of lemon zest, a touch of creamy sweetness and a perfume of pear blossom. As soon as you take a sip, your palette begins a beautiful journey from the tip of your tongue where the acidity tingles your mouth awake to the weight of the creamy, round, and soft texture which shows just a bit of oak influence that is balanced with acidity. Finally the flavor is captured on the roof of your mouth with flavors that linger on as a fond memory, well after they finish. The wine's zippy salinity pairs elegantly with a spicy sashimi, or a dish of lemon buttered scallops and charred broccolini.
