This classic Cabernet site is certified Organic, dry farmed and untilled and lives in the very center of the Rutherford AVA, world renowned for some of Napa Valley's best Cabernet Sauvignons. The York vineyard is set in a gravelly benchland that runs between the Silverado Trail and the cool Napa River. The cool nights of this region balance out the warm days and bring a lifted acidity to balance the dark fruit of this varietal. We took our time in aging this wine before release, but still recommend further time in bottle before it truly sings.

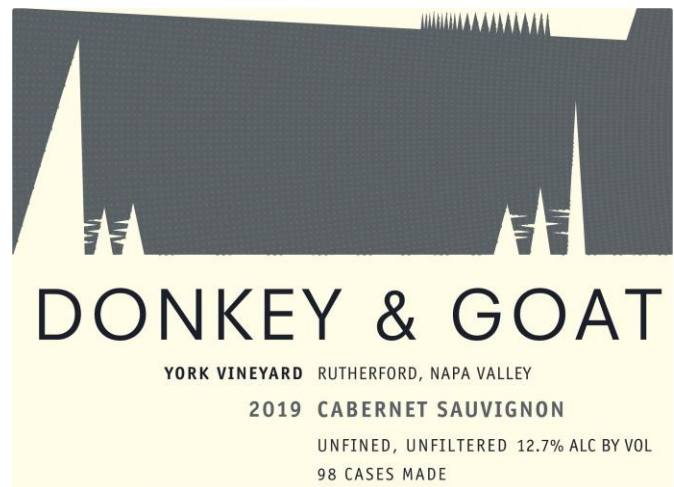

Tasting Note:

A bright and exuberant wine, this is a Cab as much for the dance floor as the dining room. Notes of cherry cola and vanilla burst forward, followed by hints of woodchips and dust, sassafras, and raw almonds. This wine wants to groove, and will have you in a party dress in no time! But don't be fooled by its playfulness, this Cab has a serious edge and will hold its own alongside any steak or roast.
