



## 2014 Chardonnay, Linda Vista Vineyard, Napa Valley

*It was bound to happen. After making wine in Berkeley for 11 years how could we not finally head to the nearby Napa Valley for fruit. The vines are farmed by Steve Matthiasson and we were lucky enough to get a little in 2014 and a bit more in 2015.*

Appellation: Napa Valley

Vineyard: Linda Vista

Varietal: Chardonnay

Clone: Davis clone 4

Age: 26 years

Elevation: 98 feet

Soil: Predominantly Cole silt loam

Yield: 4 tons/acre

Harvested: August 22, 2014

Pressed: August 22, 2014

Blend: 100% Linda Vista Chardonnay

Fermentation: 100% once used French Oak barrels

Barrel aging: 8.5 months in once used FO barrels

Bottled: Unfiltered on May 5, 2015

Production: 69 cases

Release date: Fall 2015

*Notes of lemon brioche, green apples and honey with just a kiss of herbal notes on the nose. We aged in once used French Oak barrels which lends the wine a more lavish style with depth and texture balanced by bright acidity.*
