Our white Rhône style blend where we let the vintage inspire our final blend. In 2011 we skin fermented both Grenache Blanc and Vermentino and added a little Picpoul! The final blend is 50% Marssane, 34% Grenache Blanc (with half skin fermented), 14% skin fermented Vermentino and 2% Picpoul. This is a white wine with a red's backbone that has the stuffing for the fall and winter table.
